This conference is open to law enforcement officials, prosecutors, probation/parole officers and victim advocates. The sessions this year will cover a range of topics including leadership, cultural intelligence, legal updates, AI, ghost guns, responding to school violence, financial wellness, CBP overview, and crimes against persons.

This annual event is a combined partnership between the Northern and Southern District of Indiana U.S. Attorney's Offices, the Indiana Criminal Justice Institute and MAGLOCLEN. Throughout this 2 ½ day event, you will have the opportunity to network with fellow law enforcement officials from the State of Indiana. We are expecting to fill all slots very quickly. Police will earn ILEA credit and prosecutors will earn Continuing Legal Education credits (legal and non-legal subject matter) for attendance at the conference.

Thursday Keynote:

Jake Boyd, Sergeant, Texas Department of Public Safety

Jake Boyd has been in law enforcement since 2009. He has served with the Texas Department of Public Safety since 2012. During his time with the Texas Highway Patrol, Boyd became part of the Texas Crimes Against Children Interdiction for the Protection of Children (IPC) program. While assigned to the Texas Highway Patrol Region 1D of Texas, Boyd made multiple IPC traffic stops resulting in child rescues and investigations being initiated. Boyd was also assigned to assist Troopers identify and rescue endangered or exploited children and identify those who pose a high-risk threat to a child. Boyd coordinated with Victim Services, the Texas Fusion Center and Texas Department of Family and Protective Services to assist in locating missing children and at-risk children. He also completed the 40-hour Specialist Interview course instructed by Dr. Joe Sullivan, Forensic Solutions, Ireland. Boyd is a Master Peace Officer with a Master's Degree of Science in Criminal Justice. He currently oversees the IPC program as a Sergeant in the Training Operations Division – Crimes Against Persons Training Unit.

You are certifying that you are a full-time certified law enforcement officer, prosecutor, or criminal justice official working for a county, local or state agency within Indiana.
